## An introduction on St Pius X Catholic School...

Dear Parents, Carers and Stakeholders

We would like to welcome you to the first issue of our newsletter which we will deliver regularly in the area to keep you up to date with the construction work taking place at St Pius X Catholic School.

ENGIE is working with The Department for Education to deliver a new teaching block for St Pius X Catholic School.

Phase one works, the new build teaching block, commences on the 15th April 2019 with a planned completion of February 2020.

Phase two works including the demolition of the existing block and all external works will commence February 2020 and will be complete in July 2020.

The works planned over the first few weeks include the installation of the site hoarding, safety and directional signage, delivery of welfare units, followed by the reduce level excavation and site clearance.

Our site working hours are: 8.00am to 6.00pm Monday to Friday and 9.00am until 1.00pm Saturday's.

Should you have any queries we will do everything possible to help and assist you. If you visit the school site, please follow the pedestrian signs to the site office or phone the site team whose details are on the next page.

Otherwise please contact our Customer Care Team on 0800 019 0919 between 8.30am and 5pm, Monday to Friday. If your call is outside these hours it will be

answered by our out of hours team.

However, if you see any suspicious activity on the site out of working hours please contact the Police directly.

Noise and disruption is inevitable with any construction work but please be assured we will do everything possible to keep this to a minimum.
